About our Collection System

The sewer collection system is owned, operated and maintained by the Town. It consists of approximately nine miles of gravity sewer lines, two miles of pressure lines, and two sewer pump stations. Each day we transport an average of 165,000 gallons of wastewater to the South Burlington Wastewater Treatment Plant for final treatment.

System Performance

The Town works hard to ensure the collection system is operated and maintained at a high level. We are pleased to report that there were no permit violations or overflows during the past year.
