About our Collection System:

The sewer collection system is owned, operated and maintained by the Town. It consists of approximately twelve miles of gravity sewer lines, three miles of pressure lines, and three sewer pump stations. Each day we transport 190,000 gallons of wastewater to the South Burlington Wastewater Treatment Plant for final treatment.

System Performance:


The Town works hard to ensure the collection system is operated and maintained at a high level. The Town had one sanitary sewer overflow of approximately 6,000 gallons in January 2010.
