

MINUTES FOR THE TOWN OF SWEPSONVILLE  
TOWN COUNCIL MEETING OF DECEMBER 15TH, 2009.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Raymond Herring.

Mayor Raymond Herring, Mayor Pro Tem Hugh Doss, Elvin Briggs, Darrell Newton, Doug Scott were all present.

The Town Council remembered the passing of Ronnie Crutchfield. Ronnie was born and raised in Swepsonville.

The minutes for the meeting November 17th, 2009 were reviewed. Elvin Briggs made a motion to accept the minutes as written. Hugh Doss seconded the motion. The minutes for the meeting November 17th, 2009 were unanimously approved.

Angela Stewart, Town Clerk, swore in Raymond Herring, Darrell Newton, and Hugh Doss into the Town Council.

Raymond Herring was nominated for Mayor. Hugh Doss made a motion to accept Raymond Herring as Mayor. Doug Scott seconded the motion. The vote passed unanimously. Raymond Herring is to serve a 2 year term for Mayor.

Hugh Doss was nominated for Mayor Pro-Tem. Doug Scott made a motion to accept Hugh Doss as Mayor Pro-Tem. Darrell Newton seconded the motion. The vote passed unanimously. Hugh Doss is to serve a 2 year term for Mayor Pro-Tem.

The Mayor also noted that the Town Council wants to keep Doug Scott as the Town finance officer.

The Mayor gave a water line update. Bob Vaughn Lane will be online on 12/16/09. Jerry Warren has been paid \$39,157.83 on Contract #2. Jerry's crew is now working on George Bason Road. Jerry Warren will want a draw on the part that is done on George Bason Road.

The Mayor told the Town Council that we are having problems with the Main pump Station. On 12/04/09 power shut down and Duke Power had to be called in. Duke Power came and said a fuse had blown. They changed

Doug Scott asked about an invoice for Simmons Engineering Survey. The Mayor told him it was for the Riversedge Subdivision sidewalks and water-sewer utilities for a DOT Encroachment Agreement. Town staff is working with the Riversedge Homeowners Association to have DOT to take ownership of the streets in that subdivision.

The Town Council discussed end of year bonuses for Angela, Hugh, and Raymond. Darrell Newton made a motion to accept the end of year bonuses. Elvin Briggs seconded the motion. Darrell Newton, Elvin Briggs, and Doug Scott voted for end of year bonuses. Mayor and Hugh didn't vote because of the conflict.

Hugh Doss made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Elvin Briggs seconded the motion. The meeting was unanimously adjourned.
