

MINUTES FOR THE TOWN OF SWEPSONVILLE
TOWN COUNCIL MEETING OF DECEMBER 18TH, 2007

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Raymond Herring.

All Town Council members were present.

The minutes for the meeting November 20TH, 2007 were reviewed. Elvin Briggs made a motion to accept the minutes as written. Hugh Doss seconded the motion. The minutes for the meeting November 20th, 2007 were unanimously approved.

Elvin Briggs and Doug Scott were sworn in to a four year term on the Swepsonville Town Council by Town Clerk, Dana Stout.

Nominations were taking for Mayor. Raymond Herring was nominated by Hugh Doss. Marvin Shebester seconded the motion. The Town Council passed the vote unanimously.

Nominations were taking for Mayor Pro Tem. Hugh Doss was nominated by Marvin Shebester. Elvin Briggs seconded the motion. The Town Council passed the vote unanimously.

The Town Council reviewed the bids on the Quarry Hill Lift Station Upgrade. The bids ranged from \$229,512.50 to \$131,925.00. Mark Averette with AWCK recommended the low bid of \$131,925.00 be accepted. The bid was entered by Breece Enterprise. Elvin Briggs made a motion to accept the bid offer. Marvin Shebester seconded the motion. The Town Council passed the vote unanimously.

Paul Koonts reviewed Alamance County Ordinances listed below with the Council:

- A. Sexually Oriented Businesses
- B. Alamance County High Impact Land Use Polluting Industries Ordinance
- C. Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance
- D. Wireless Communication Facilities Ordinance

After hearing from Mr. Koonts it was agreed on that this matter would be brought back before the Council at a later date.

DOT requested the street around a manhole in the 2300 block of Crescent Dr. be repaired. The cost will be \$1400.00. Pro-Pav will do the work. Hugh Doss made a motion to fix the street. Elvin Briggs seconded the motion. The Town Council passed the vote unanimously.

The Town was approved for a grant in the amount of \$8,750.00 to pave the main entrance at the Swepsonville River Park.

The Town was also reimbursed \$11,571.72 from the Haw River Trails Grant.

Gail Miller of Hickory Run spoke in the Open Time-Public Comment. Her questions were about the new pump station. She wanted to know where the sewer lines were going to be run. Also she was asking about the water lines and how they run.

Darrell Newton was recognized for all the many services he has done for the Town of Swepsonville. Darrell was also given a plaque for the renaming of Swepsonville-Saxapahaw Road (beginning at Boywood Road to East Main Street) to Darrell Newton Drive.

Hugh Doss made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Marvin Shebester seconded the motion. The meeting was unanimously adjourned.
