

MINUTES FOR THE TOWN OF SWEPSONVILLE  
TOWN COUNCIL MEETING OF OCTOBER 20TH, 2009.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Raymond Herring.

Mayor Raymond Herring, Mayor Pro Tem Hugh Doss, Elvin Briggs, Darrell Newton, Doug Scott were all present.

Paul Koonts, Town Attorney, was not present due to back surgery.

The Town Council noted the passing of Mr. Don Thompson, 84 of Asheville. Don grew up here in Swepsonville and went on to play major league baseball with the Boston Braves and the Brooklyn Dodgers from 1949-1953.

The minutes for the meeting September 15th, 2009 were reviewed. Elvin Briggs made a motion to accept the minutes as written. Doug Scott seconded the motion. The minutes for the meeting September 15th, 2009 were unanimously approved.

Troy Woodard from Mid Carolina Bank came to give the Town Council information on the Virginia Mills Property. He stated that the property is in procedure of foreclosure. A Brownfield study is being conducted on the property by DENA and the study is incomplete. More tests may be required.

Franz Holt, Town's Engineer with Alley, Williams, Carmen, & King, Franz explained to the Town Council that bids were taken at the Town Hall on October 19, 2009. Contract #1 is an 8" water line going down George Bason Road and Darrell Newton Drive with 3 new fire Hydrants. The bid amount is \$80,970.00. Contract #2 is a 6" water line going down Bob Vaughn Lane with 2 new fire hydrants. The bid amount is \$46,011.25. Contract #3 is a 6" water line on Hwy 54 and George Bason Road. the bid amount is \$7,282.50. C & J Utilities placed the lowest bid on the water line project. The total amount for the bid is \$134,263.75. Darrell Newton made a motion to accept the bid made by C & J Utilities. Hugh Doss seconded the motion. The bids from C & J Utilities were unanimously approved.

The Town Council entered into a contract agreement with the engineering firm of Alley, Williams, Carmen, and King. To be the Town's


Engineer on the 3 water line improvements for the sum not to exceed \$7500.00. Darrell Newton made a motion to accept the Engineer Contract from Alley, Williams, Carmen, & King. Hugh Doss seconded the motion. The contract was approved unanimously.

The Town Council received two requests for street lights. One being on the corner of Hwy 54 and George Bason Road. The other being on Viewmont Drive and Swep-Sax Road. Hugh Doss made a motion to approve the street lights. Doug Scott seconded the motion. The street lights were unanimously approved. Council member Scott stated a sharp curve on E. Main St. in front of 1620 could use a light also. The Mayor said he would look at that location for a light also.

The Town Council discussed the need for a Tobacco Use Policy or Ordinance. Darrell Newton made a motion to take no action. Doug Scott seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved.

During Public comment Kevin Pickard 1064 George Bason Rd. thanked the Town Council for the water line improvements on George Bason Rd.

Hugh Doss made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Doug Scott seconded the motion. The meeting was unanimously adjourned.
